BAY OF COLWYN TOWN COUNCIL'S CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERING GRANT APPLICATIONS FROM VOLUNTARY AND CHARITABLE BODIES

- 1. All Applications shall be considered by the Policy and Finance Committee.
- 2. The Council must receive all applications of over £500 by the 31st December for awarding grants in the following financial year (after 1st April). These applications will be considered in January and late applications will not be considered.
- 3. The Policy & Finance Committee will consider applications of £500 and less, quarterly.
- 4. The Town Council requires all applicants for financial assistance to have a written constitution and separate bank account and to provide an audited statement of their financial affairs.
- 5. After consideration by the Policy & Finance Committee and ratification by the Town Council, the Town Clerk will inform all applicants, in writing, whether or not their application has been successful.
- 6. Funds given to any organisation must be used to benefit the residents of the geographical area represented by the Town Council i.e. Rhos-on-Sea, Colwyn Bay and Old Colwyn, either directly or indirectly.
- 7. The onus is on the Organisation to submit its application to the Town Council. **The Council will not distribute application forms automatically**.
- 8. Organisations should be aware that any award made and the amount thereof is at the discretion of the Town Council. **Grants are not on-going year on year.** The applicant shall indicate other funding applied for/granted from other organisations, including other Local Councils, and give evidence of fund raising activities already undertaken.
- 9. Any organisation / applicant receiving a grant of £500 or more in any one financial year will be required to provide a written report of how the money has been used. The report must be provided within 6 months of the end of the financial year in which the grant was made (i.e. by 30th September). If a report is not provided within the 6 month period, all future applications may be placed in jeopardy.
- 10. Grants of £1,000 and over awarded to support revenue expenditure will be paid in two instalments, in April and October, and any subsequent successful application may be reduced by 20% each year to encourage applicants to secure alternative long term sustainable funding sources.
- 11. Grants of £1,000 and over awarded for capital purchases may be paid in either one or two instalments, at the discretion of the Committee.
- 12. Applications should be submitted to the Bay of Colwyn Town Council, Town Hall, Rhiw Road, Colwyn Bay, LL29 7TE and will be acknowledged.
