1/16 WELCOME:

2/16 ELECTION OF MAYOR:

Nominations were called for the Office of Town Mayor for the new municipal year.

Councillor Mrs V Smith J.P. proposed Councillor John Davies as Town Mayor for the year 2016-17. Councillor S Taylor seconded the nomination.
