262/18 Welcome and Apologies for Absence:

In the absence of the Chair, Cllr C Brockley (Vice Chair) took the Chair. The Chairman welcomed members to the meeting and apologies for absence were received from Cllrs: G Baker, D Bradley and J Pearson and the Town Clerk, Mrs T Earley.

263/18 <u>Declarations of Interest</u>:

Members were reminded that they must declare the existence and nature of any personal and/or prejudicial interests.

264/18 Minutes:

Resolved to approve and sign, as a correct record, the minutes of the last meeting, held on 30th October 2018.

265/18 <u>Matters Arising from Previous Minutes:</u>

a) Min.229/18 (a) – Hesketh Road Bus Shelter:

The Assistant Clerk submitted a copy of the letter sent to NW Police from Conwy CBC. Any response would be referred to a future meeting.

It was noted by members that CCBC will be seeking expressions of interest from private contractors to run the regular weekly markets.

Cllr C Matthews reported that he has sent an email to NWAMI requesting information concerning where the instruments were located and their condition. He received an invite to inspect them but no location or time and has not received any response to further emails.

d) Min 234/18 – Remembrance Sunday:

Members reported on the high attendance at all 3 Remembrance events; both the services at the War Memorials in Colwyn Bay and Old Colwyn had been well attended and the Mayor remarked on how moving it was especially as it was the centenary year. Over 6000 people has attended the Pages of the Sea event which was especially moving as the image had been swept away by the sea at 11 o'clock.

Reports were requested from members following their recent inspection of notice boards. Cllr M Jones submitted a picture of Tan Lan noticeboard which members agreed needed urgent refurbishment. The members were thanked for their inspections.
