

GRANT FUNDING CRITERIA – YOUTH GRANTS

The Bay of Colwyn Town Council has committed £5,000 to support projects for young people living in the Town Council's area (Rhos on Sea, Colwyn Bay, Upper Colwyn Bay and Old Colwyn). The aim of the funding is to support projects for young people which can demonstrate links to the seven national wellbeing seven set out in the Welsh Government's Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015 (see attached).

GUIDELINES

1. All Applications shall be considered by the Policy and Finance Committee. After consideration by the Policy & Finance Committee and ratification by the Town Council, the Town Clerk will inform all applicants, in writing, whether or not their application has been successful.
2. Projects must be for the benefit of young people (under 25) living in the Bay of Colwyn area.
3. The maximum funding requested for any project should be **£1,000**. This could be a part of your overall costs and we may be able to offer advice on additional sources of funding.
4. Applicants should be existing fully constituted voluntary or other not-for-profit organisations with a separate bank account, and be able to provide recent audited accounts and/or bank statement(s).
5. Applications must be submitted on the attached form, either printed or electronically, to: **Bay of Colwyn Town Council, Rhiw Road, Colwyn Bay, LL29 7TE** or **by e-mail to: info@colwyn-tc.gov.uk**
6. The deadline for Project submissions is **Monday 31st January 2022**. Applications received after that deadline will not be considered. Acknowledgement of receipt will be sent by e-mail, where possible.
7. Depending upon the nature of the Project, and if approved for grant funding, you may be required to complete a simple service level agreement with the Town Council.
8. Any organisation / applicant receiving a grant of £500 or more in any one financial year will be required to provide a written report of how the money has been used. The report must be provided within 6 months of the end of the financial year in which the grant was made (i.e. by 30th September).
9. Organisations should be aware that any award made and the amount thereof is at the discretion of the Town Council. The applicant shall indicate other funding applied for/granted from other organisations, including other Local Councils, and give evidence of fund raising activities already undertaken.
