# 277/21 Welcome and Apologies for Absence

The Chair welcomed all members to the meeting. No apologies for absence were received.

#### 278/21 Declarations of Interest:

Members were reminded that they must declare the existence and nature of any personal and/or prejudicial interests.

The Clerk and Cllr M Worth declared a personal (non-prejudicial) interest in regard to agenda item 10a (see Min. 285 (a) Planning Application No 0/49160) due to being Trustees at the Bryn Cadno Community Centre and left the meeting during the discussion about this agenda item.

#### 279/21 Minutes:

Resolved to approve and sign, as a correct record, the minutes of the last meeting, held on 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2021.

## 280/21 Conwy CBC:

The Clerk submitted a copy of Disabled People's Parking Notice for the Town Council area which was noted by members.

#### 281/21 Noticeboards:

Members had been asked to inspect the noticeboards in their wards and their observations had been added to the street furniture spreadsheet, which the Clerk displayed on screen. It was noted that all the money had been allocated from this year's budget for the two noticeboards at Colwyn Avenue, Rhos on Sea and the large Noticeboard in the Centre of Colwyn Bay, which were both being replaced. The Noticeboards at the Town Hall and Cefn Road, Old Colwyn both need new backing. Resolved to add this item to a future agenda to review the noticeboards that need attention in the next financial year.

#### 282/21 Welsh Government:

The Clerk submitted a TAN (Technical Advice Note) regarding TAN 15 and associated Flooding for planning.

Resolved to recommend that members look on the Welsh Government Website to view the Flood Risk Map, to check for any impact in our area and for the Clerk to contact Conwy CBC to ask for any information on any review that had taken place in the Bay of Colwyn Area.

The Clerk reported that she had sought advice from SLCC (Society of Clerks), OVW (One Voice Wales) and HMRC over correct payment of the allowances. She did advise that there may be an exemption from paying tax in the future, as lobbying was currently taking place, and would keep members informed.
