259/23 Welcome and Apologies for Absence:

In the absence of the Chair, Cllr John Clayton (Vice Chair) took the Chair for the meeting and welcomed members. Apologies for absence were received from Cllr L Kennedy and R Owen (Chair).

260/23 Declarations of Interest:

Members were reminded that they must declare the existence and nature of any personal and/or prejudicial interests. None were declared.

261/23 Minutes:

Resolved to approve and sign, as a correct record, the minutes of the last meeting, held on 12th December 2023.

262/23 Matters Arising from Previous Minutes

a) Min 244/23(a) Festive Lighting, Penrhyn Avenue, Rhos on Sea:

An update was received regarding the removal of the columns. A county councillor reported that they were due to be removed earlier today, but due to issues with parking signage and objections from one of the shop-keepers about the installation of a new signpost, they were unable to proceed. A further meeting is needed with parking/highways to discuss the situation and agree a solution.

b) Min 244/23(b) Bus Shelters:

i) It was noted that no response about the requirements for sites for living roof shelters had been received.

Resolved to refer the query to the main ERF helpline to chase a response.

ii) Cllr C Brockley reported that the Shelter on Church Road, Rhos on Sea had lost its roof.

Resolved to report this to ERF, Conwy CBC.

c) Min 246/23 Street Furniture Q3 Inspection:

The inventory was updated following inspections by members/staff of any street furniture in their area. As some items had not yet been inspected, members were asked to email their observations to the Clerk as soon as possible.

Resolved to defer this to the next meeting and for the staff to carry out any inspections that had not been completed by that date.

263/23 Conwy CBC:

a) Better Open Space Management:

The Clerk submitted a request from Conwy CBC for suggested locations where CCTV coverage is needed, together with the reason(s), i.e. graffiti, litter, fly-tipping, anti-social behaviour, plus any evidence they may have to back this up. In answer to questions, the Clerk confirmed these were deployed cameras which could be moved around and that CCTV was monitored 24/7 in a control room at Coed Pella offices. The Clerk informed members that she could arrange a visit to the control room for members, if there is sufficient demand.

The following locations were suggested by members:

- i) Maes Glas, Rhos on Sea: anti-social behaviour; drug dealing and dog fouling was reported as being an issue in this area.
- ii) Glyn Ward:
 - (1) Maes Y Fron by the alley between Maes Y Fron and Maes Y Fron: constant littering and graffiti in the alley and issues with anti-social behaviour.
 - (2) The Junction of Severn Road and Maes Y Glyn: long standing issues with antisocial behaviour and littering on Maes y Fron and the flats on Severn Road.
- (3) Junction of Ffordd Bugail and Ffordd Hafryn: a lot of problems with Anti-Social Behaviour and drug related activities.
- (4) Ysgol Bod Alaw have had issues with individuals entering the site after normal school hours and climbing on the roof.

Resolved to submit these 5 locations to Conwy CBC for consideration and to request that members contact the Clerk if they would be interested in attending a visit to the CCTV Control Room.

Happy New Year!

Sorry for the delay getting back to you on this. There is no real criteria, the issue we have is the shelters are quite large and to support the weight of the green roof they need to be a certain type. Unfortunately because the one at St Paul's needs to be a walk through it wasn't suitable. I know it was my suggestion, it's a learning curve for me too. I do think this shelter would benefit from some TLC at some point if you want to consider it.

I will have a look at some other options for green shelter locations and come back to you as soon as possible.

I've been dealing with the Church Road, Rhos shelter this week. It has sustained some quite significant damage to the roof and isn't repairable so we need to either replace it or remove it. The cost to replace is approximately £6,000. Could you let me know how you'd like me to proceed please?

The current balance in your holding account is £13,927.00.

In terms of an update, we continue to arrange repairs as and when required and are grateful for any reports from yourselves if there are any areas of concern.

We've had issues with our Contractor that would usually complete the round of shelter cleans and this has delayed the latest round but we are just in the process of confirming these works with a new contractor and hope to complete a clean before the new year. We will confirm details as soon as possible. You have sufficient funds in your holding account to look at some more proactive works should you wish to, let me know if you want me to look at any improvements anywhere and I can check suitability and get some quotes for any required works.

Thank you for your emails - we rely very heavily on volunteers to keep our grounds clear and are extremely grateful to people who clear up the rubbish. Recently, Kenny and his team from the Youth Shedz did a sterling job.

Now, the mess that we encounter daily has increased - and the amount of household rubbish and dog bags is becoming a health hazard too.

It's got to a point that we cannot expect volunteers to remove what the public are depositing there.

A few years ago, as a church, we bid for a grant from the local council to purchase the bins - in the hope the

bins would keep the area tidy.

We also pay Thorncliffe to come and empty a paladin on a fortnightly basis. Never did we anticipate that as Conwy reduced their weekly collections, the household rubbish

would be brought to the bins in the church grounds - and attracting gulls etc.

We have recently had communication from Thorncliffe that from April 6, when the new laws come in with regard separating ALL rubbish - this could possibly include such bins. If this is the case, we are going to have to consider the removal of the bins from the church grounds as it's beyond all expectation to ask anyone to go through them.

Sadly, they were never intended for household rubbish and dog bags - which people drop / bring here as they don't walk their dogs in the grounds.

I'm sorry I don't have an immediate answer or a clean up team to combat this unsightly problem. I'm as embarrassed by it as many are when I see what people have left here.

Whether 'the council 'could please do a 'one off' emptying of the bins to get us started and lower the rubbish in them now ... so we can try and keep on top of it? Kenny has requested a key to help us too.

Have you any suggestions, Roz?

As one of the councillors representing Rhiw Ward, you may have been aware of the proposed re-development of Guys Cliff nursing home to provide 23 affordable apartments, and that a planning application has very recently been submitted.

I am writing on behalf of the residents of Alexandra Road, who are almost unanimous in believing that this development should not go ahead for the reasons given below. We would be grateful for your support.

As the brief document attached shows (with plans), the proposed 3-storey building extends far beyond the existing building-line and is completely out of scale and character in relation to the surroundings and would involve the destruction of green space and the removal of mature trees. In addition we believe that the severely limited parking provided in the plan will inevitably lead to more on-street parking on Alexandra Road, where day-time parking can already be very congested.

We understand the pressures on the County Council to provide more housing, including affordable housing, and to promote public transport (and walking!) rather than private cars. These are important aims, but we would argue that they should not outweigh the Council's own policies – that buildings should be in character with their surroundings, and that sufficient parking space should be provided in residential properties "to avoid the need for vehicles to park on-street and thereby cause congestion, danger and visual intrusion" (LDP2 4.5)"

I realise that we have been slow in contacting you, as the deadline for comments is February 1st, but we would be grateful for any support you are able to give on this issue.
