

**MINUTES OF A HYBRID MEETING OF THE BAY OF COLWYN TOWN COUNCIL AT 6.30^{PM} ON MONDAY
28th APRIL 2025**

502/24 Welcome and Apologies for Absence:

Cllr J Nuttall took the Chair, in the absence of the Mayor, and welcomed members to the meeting. Apologies for absence were received from the Mayor, Cllr R Owen, and from Town Cllrs: J Clayton, N Coverley, P Hughes, D Jones, A Khan and K Roberts and County Cllr G Jones. The Chair said a few words about Cllr Colin Matthews who had sadly passed away suddenly last month and a minute's silence was observed.

503/24 Announcements:

- (a) The Clerk reminded members in the room about meeting etiquette: - to introduce themselves before speaking (to give the Owl time to pan around) and to project their voice towards the Owl or the extender mic. Members on zoom were asked to use the participation 'hands up' button if they wished to speak.
- (b) The Clerk reported on the Colwyn Bay Conversation (Town Centre Engagement Event) which is being held on Thursday 1st May. The event is now almost at full capacity and bookings will close by noon tomorrow (Tuesday). If anyone hasn't yet booked a place (or is not sure if they have) and wants to attend, please book via Eventbrite by tomorrow morning at latest. Due to the need for table plans and catering numbers, walk-ins on the day won't be possible.
- (c) The Deputy Mayor reported on her recent engagements which she had attended due to the Mayor's recent illness: High Sheriff's Awards held at Rydal School, High School Musical at Theatr Colwyn, 100th Birthday of a Veteran Mochdre resident Mr John Evans (Chair of Mochdre, Cllr Price had been in attendance as well) and Pope Francis's Memorial Service in St Joseph's.

504/24 Declarations of Interest:

Members were reminded that they must declare the existence and nature of any personal and/or prejudicial interests.

505/24 Visitor(s) to the Council:

- (a) Members noted that representatives from Theatr and Oriel Colwyn had been invited to attend the meeting to give a brief presentation. Apologies had been given by the Theatre Manager as Monday's were inconvenient. A special meeting could be arranged on another evening, the invitation could be issued to an alternative representative or we could ask for

an invitation for councillors to attend the next planned Management Committee (perhaps requesting this be held in the evening).

Resolved to request that the Theatr Colwyn Management Committee representatives discuss these options with the CCBC representatives at the next meeting.

(b) County Councillors Reports – The Past Mayor, Cllr H Fleet reported that she had attended a boating engagement which Llandrillo College had organised in Anglesey.

(c) Public participation: There were no members of the public present.

506/24 Minutes

507/24 Matters Arising from Those Minutes

(a) Min. 434/24(a) and 467/24(b)– Congo Delegation: Members received and noted the notes and RG gave a brief report from the meeting with delegates from the DRC, facilitated by Adferiad and held on 11.4.24 (Cllr JC and RG had been in attendance). It was noted a grant application had now been submitted for the October event and this would be considered by the Policy & Finance Committee.

(b) Min. 436/24(a) – Council Vacancies: Members noted that Conwy CBC will now be advised of the vacancy in Glyn ward and that five of the current members have been co-opted (21%), with one third (33%) being the maximum permitted to retain the General Power of Competence. As a mark of respect, funeral arrangements for the late Cllr Matthews would be awaited before the vacancy is advertised.

(c) Min. 436/24(b)– Town Hall Tower Repairs: Members received the final summary of costs and were asked to approve payment of the final invoice for completion of the repairs.

Resolved to approve payment of the final invoice (£24,798.23) for completion of the repairs.

(d) Min. 436/24(c) & 462/24(g)– Gardd Pawb:

(i) Members received and noted the final detailed summary of expenditure for the grant-funded project. The Clerk confirmed that the project had come within budget. The staff were thanked for all their efforts in completing the project in time and within budget.

(ii) Members noted that the final payment of the grant funds has now been received.

(iii) Members noted that the signed lease has been received from CCBC.

(iv) Members were asked to consider approving the allocation of the £1,500 received for staff evaluation of the project to the Colwyn in Bloom budget for 2025/26, to enable the monthly facilitated gardening sessions to continue from April to October 2025 (inclusive).

Resolved to approve the allocation of the £1,500 to the Colwyn in Bloom budget for 2025/26, to enable the monthly facilitated gardening sessions to continue from April to

October 2025

- (e) The Clerk reported that the water harvesting pipe would be installed on Thursday and the installer would also be asked to fit the lockable taps, if possible.
Resolved to ratify the purchase of two lockable tap (£15 each approx) and epoxy resin to prevent the IBC (water bowsers) being emptied again.
- (f) Min. 436/24(g) and 466/24 – Local Members Ward Allowances: Members received the final summary for 2024/25 and noted the balance of unspent allowances (£1,260) was transferred over to the small grants budget, in accordance with Council policy.
- (g) Min. 436/24(k) – VE Day 2025:
- (i) Members noted the VE Day events grants approved by the P&F Committee in March (SCH D to those Minutes). The Clerk reported on some of the VE Day events (funded by TC) which were taking place: St Paul's Church Service to mark the 80th anniversary of VE Day, Colwyn Hub VE Day Celebrations (details had been shared with members) and Make Do & Mend Repair Event organised by T4C Bay. CH reported that several businesses were organising events/window displays in the Town to attract footfall.
 - (ii) Members were asked to consider an extra grant request from Rhos Rotary for a VE Day Service to be held in URC Rhos and to share the event information.
Resolved to approve the small grant of £250 for the Rhos Rotary VE Day event.
- (h) Contract Cleaner for the Town Hall:
Resolved to defer this item to the next meeting, as one quotation was still awaited.
- (i) Min. 467/24(a) – Small Grants:
- (i) **Resolved to ratify approval of the small grant to the Welsh Air Ambulance.**
As Trustees, Cllrs H Fleet, J Higgins and J Nuttall declared a personal but non-prejudicial interest in the following item:
 - (ii) **Resolved to ratify the year-end donations to the Sir John Henry Morris Jones Trust and the Llandrillo Ancient Charities (£1,870 and £3,740 respectively).**
- (j) Min. 467/24(b) – Events Grants:
- (i) Members noted the summary of events grants 2024/25
 - (ii) **Resolved to approve the carry forward the remaining funds for the Beach of Dreams event grant to 2025/26, to cover the 10th May event costs.**
 - (iii) **Resolved to approve payment of the advance invoice (for 60%) in relation to Kinetika's costs for the exhibition and boom bikes at the 10th May event and to delegate authority to the Clerk to sign the hire agreement for the Pennant Exhibition, once conditions of hire have been clarified.**
- (k) Min. 467/24(c) – Well-being Grants: Members received further information in respect of application E and were asked to ratify approval of grants to applicants D and E, subject to the conditions detailed in the recommendations of the Committee.
Resolved to ratify approval of grants to applicants D and E, subject to the conditions detailed in the recommendations of the Committee.
- (l) Min. 448/24 – Volunteer Awards Presentations:
Resolved to ratify the recommendations of the committee regarding awards to be presented for 2024/25 and agreed to trial having the presentation of the Volunteer Awards immediately following the Council's Annual Meeting, to be held on Monday 19th May at 6:30pm (and followed by refreshments).
- (m) Colwyn in Bloom Committee: Members received and considered the approval of the updated Terms of Reference for the Committee. Cllr A Jones declared her interest in filling

the Councillor vacancy which would be debated later in the agenda.

Resolved to also contact the Business Forum regarding representation on the Committee.

- (n) Fireworks Event 2025: Members noted feedback from the trial event in 2024 and received a copy of the event budget/expenditure summary and were asked to consider any recommendations of the Sub-Committee regarding the 2025 event. The Sub-Committee had unanimously agreed that the waterfront location was a better location for the display, for safety and accessibility reasons. It was noted that the only negative feedback on last year's event was that, due to marine licensing delay issues, no concessions had been allowed on site, however this would not be an issue this year and the event space can be extended for food/drink stalls and a small children's funfair.

A debate ensued around some of the costs included in the budget for the 2025 event, particularly those for Conwy CBCs staff/services. It was noted that Conwy CBC recharge these costs to all organisations using their services for community events.

It was proposed and seconded that the recommendations of the Sub-Committee to proceed with the event on the Promenade this year, with the addition of a Marine License and concessions.

An alternative proposal was made that the event is not held and residents be advised to travel to the Llandudno event instead.

A point of order was raised at this point, as the event budget had been approved by the Town Council in January, and this motion would therefore be in contravention of the Council's Standing Order regarding rescinding a previous resolution (which would require written notice from four councillors).

The original proposal was then put to the vote.

Resolved to approve all of the recommendations of the Sub-Committee, as detailed in the Minutes of that meeting.

- Cllrs S Price and D Carr left the meeting at this juncture.

- (o) ***Resolved to note the resolutions of the Committees/Sub-Committees, as detailed in the Minutes.***

508/24 Welsh /UK Government – Members noted the following correspondence:

- (a) Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru – members noted that the new Commission will replace the IRPW from 1/4/25.

509/24 Conwy CBC:

- (a) Public Conveniences (see Min. 464/24(a): Members noted that the Clerk had requested a follow up meeting with CCBC to discuss the draft service level agreement and proposed arrangements for regular financial reporting/invoicing, but that a date has not yet been agreed (the Clerk had since been asked to collate questions/comments from other Clerks/Councils in advance of any meeting). A further update from Conwy CBC was tabled, confirming that CCBC would still manage the facilities with funding support (sponsorship) from the Town Council to cover the operating costs. The proposed plan for providing accessible public toilets at Porth Eirias was discussed and several members queried the impact this would have on the other toilets on the promenade.

It was noted that the Clerk has also made enquiries as to why we were not informed that the Dingle Public conveniences had recently closed and a response is awaited (the officer is currently on leave).

- (b) Town Team – Members noted presentation slides on the achievements of the Colwyn Town Team and a received a brief verbal report on the recent Town Team meeting. The team were currently recruiting to fill any gaps in their membership. Partners had reported on any recent/planned activities, including: Purple Plaque for Ethel Hovey, Gardd Pawb and the Pride event. Christmas events had been discussed and CH said that the £5000 funding that T4CBay had received from the Town Council had now been match funded to give a budget of £47,000 towards Christmas Events in the town.
- (c) Town & Community Council Forum –The Clerk gave a brief verbal report on the meeting held on 15th April. The main agenda item had been the Regional Emergency Planning Service. The recent water crisis had been discussed and used as an example of how local Councillors can be involved. Slides will be forwarded once received.
- (d) Paddling Pools – Members received notes from a meeting called in April to give advance notice of the planned re-opening of the pools. All pools should be filled by the bank holiday weekend (3rd May).
- (e) T&CC Engagement and partnership: Members received a forward plan for meetings and were asked to consider/agree who will attend to represent the Town Council (previously been the Town Clerk, Mayor and Place Plan Manager). The priority for 7th May (1.30pm slot provisionally booked) will be giving feedback on the Colwyn Bay conversation (taking place 1st May) and the need for a group meeting to be arranged to discuss Public Toilets and SLA/Expectations of both parties.
Resolved that the Mayor, Dep Mayor, Town Clerk and Place Plan Officer attend and a slot is booked for each of the 6 forthcoming sessions.
- (f) Local Area Forum: Cllr C Hughes gave a brief verbal report from the Central LAF meeting which he had attended on 3rd April. Serious concerns had been raised over the age and the cost of repair/replacement of the viaduct bridges on the old Abergele Road in Old Colwyn. The planning status of Station Road had been discussed.

Cllr C Brockley left the meeting at this juncture.

510/24 Nominations for Mayor and Deputy Mayor and Committees for 2025/26:

- (a) The Chair asked members for nominations for the post of Mayor and Deputy Mayor (Elect), in preparation for the Annual Meeting on 19th May 2025.

The Clerk advised members that the 3 senior Councillors , Cllrs C Brockley, D Jones and S Price did not want to be considered for Deputy Mayor (Elect) this year.

It was proposed by Cllr D Wilkins and seconded by Cllr A Jones that the current Deputy Mayor, Cllr Jo Nuttall, be nominated as Town Mayor (Elect) for 2025/26.

It was proposed by Cllr D Wilkins and seconded by Cllr L Wilkins that Cllr Jason Higgins be nominated as Deputy Town Mayor (Elect) for 2024/25.

It was proposed by Cllr T Maclean and seconded by Cllr A Jones that Cllr G Wynne be nominated as Deputy Town Mayor (Elect) for 2024/25. A secret ballot was held, in accordance with the Council's Standing Orders on appointments.

Cllr J Higgins received 5 votes and Cllr G Wynne received 7 votes.

It was noted that these nominations would be submitted formally to the Annual Meeting, to be held in the Town Hall on Monday 19th May.

Resolved that Cllr Jo Nuttall be formally nominated for the office of Town Mayor and Cllr Greg Wynne for the office of Deputy Town Mayor at the annual meeting next month.

- (b) The Clerk asked for any requests from Members to switch Committees to be made prior to the re-appointment of Committees at the annual meeting in May (noting that approved switches will need to maintain the political and geographical representation of each committee). Cllr A Jones expressed her wish to be transferred to the Policy & Finance Committee if any Rhos/Dinarth Councillors wished to swap.

- (c) Vacancies on Committees/Sub-Committees.

Resolved to appoint Cllrs J Higgins and Lisa Wilkins to the Christmas Lights Committee, Cllr A Jones to the Colwyn in Bloom Committee, Tony Anderton (Secretary of OCRA) to the Old Colwyn War Memorial Committee and Cllr Chris Hughes to the Place Plan Steering Group as per schedule A attached to these minutes.

511/24 Finance and Governance:

- (a) ***Resolved to ratify payment of the first instalments of the large grants for 2025/26.***
- (b) ***Resolved to approve payment of an invoice from CCBC for £7,200 for the bus shelter maintenance budget for 2025/26.***
- (c) Members noted that work will be progressing on finalising the year-end accounts for 2024/25 during the next few weeks, in preparation for internal audit in May.

512/24 Representatives on Outside Bodies:

- (a) Members received the updated list of representatives on Outside Bodies and considered filling the vacancies there-in. As the Place Plan Steering group is now a Town Council Committee, it was agreed that this be removed from the outside bodies list. Colwyn Bay Regeneration Board, Conwy Fairtrade Coalition and Raynes Quarry were also removed due to no longer being active. It was agreed to leave the Upper Dingle LNR and Fairy Glen Advisory Group, currently inactive, in the hope that they may become active again soon. Cllr J Higgins reported he has not received any invitation to any meetings as Governor of Ysgol Bod Alaw and asked the Clerk to ask when the next meeting was.
- Resolved to update the list as above and to nominate Cllr T Maclean as Governor of Ysgol Nant y Groes, Cllr C Hughes as Trustee for Sir John Henry Morris Jones Trust Fund and Cllr P Ashe for the Theatr Colwyn Management Committee as per schedule B attached to these minutes.***
- (b) Members received any reports from the Clerk and/or Members who are representatives of the Council on outside bodies, to include:
- (i) The draft notes of an informal Police/Youth Liaison Meeting (with Glyn and Rhiw ward members), held on 16th April 2025. The Clerk reported that it had been a well-attended constructive meeting and partners were working together to deal with issues. Bay View Centre Manager reported there was a huge improvement with the anti-social problems that had been experienced in the shopping centre. A radio link scheme for business is being promoted.
- (ii) Members noted a report from a recent Army Engagement Day from Cllr T MacLean. Cllr P Ashe had also attended and his report will be shared with all members.

Resolved, by majority vote, to suspend the Council's Standing Orders at this juncture, to enable the meeting to continue past the 9pm threshold.

513/24 One Voice Wales (OVW) / NALC / Society of Local Council Clerks:

- (a)** Members received the Notice of the Launch of the new OVW website
- (b)** Members received the agenda and noted the report from the Larger Councils Committee, held on 16th April and attended by the Clerk and Cllr Price (to include a copy of the presentation slides, which will be shared by email.
- (c)** Conwy and Denbighshire Area Committee meeting, held on 15th April. It was noted that Cllr P Ashe had been unable to attend.
- (d)** Members were asked to bring any motions for the AGM to the next meeting.
- (e)** Resolved to delegate authority to the Clerk to submit a response to a survey in respect of the Area Committees. The Clerk requested that Cllr Ashe help her complete the survey, as he has attended the meetings.

514/24 Other Correspondence:

Members noted that a nomination has been submitted to the RTPi in respect of the digital engagement work carried out on the Bay of Colwyn Place Plan.
