Cyngor Tref Bae Colwyn yn Dathlu Cydnabyddiaeth Genedlaethol i'r Clerc, Tina Earley FSLCC

Mae Cyngor Tref Bae Colwyn yn falch o gyhoeddi bod y Clerc, Tina Earley FSLCC, wedi derbyn Gwobr Cydnabyddiaeth Arbennig fawreddog gan Gymdeithas Clercod Cyngorau Lleol (SLCC) - y corff proffesiynol sy'n cynrychioli clercod o dros 5,000 o gynghorau tref, plwyf a chymuned ledled Cymru a Lloegr.
